#### **JOAN BUTTS VISIT**

In March we had the pleasure of a visit to Townsville from Joan Butts.

The first day Joan held a 6 hour course for beginner bridge teachers. This was well attended, including people from Bowen, Atherton, Tully and Ingham. Each is now entitled to 15 Accreditation points towards becoming an Accredited ABF Teacher. The all-day session was very interactive and conducted in the manner that illustrated the principles to be incorporated in Bridge lessons.

The five principles are included in the acronym STEAM (Safety: ensuring students feel comfortable and free to make mistakes. Timing: Moving sessions along and keeping to time. Energy: using hands-on activities to keep energy and enthusiasm high. Attitude: friendly and encouraging, positive and helpful. Materials: Tailored to the needs of the lesson and the group.)



The second day was for players and was a session on defence, with the main themes of signals and count. Forty one people attended Joan's lesson on Defensive Play and Signalling conducted on Wednesday 21 March. The feedback was very positive.

Joan stressed the importance of giving a signal on partner's opening lead. Her preference was "low encourage" but she stressed that whichever signal you use, you should definitely use one and both understand what it was.

Joan explained the logic for giving "count". She demonstrated how this works and how it enhances ones' defensive play – by giving count in a suit, partner knows when and how long to hold up. Count also gives partner a better view of the suit distribution in their hand, giving vital information about which suit(s) to hold and which to discard.

Joan finds the perfect balance of serious comment and humour. There were many tips along the way re card play and bidding. I particularly liked the statement re slow play: "a card should be played on the day it is dealt"! and the comment re signals: if partner isn't on the same wave-length as your signals, perhaps you should find another partner!

The visit was very instructive and well received by those attending. It is great to see so many aiming to improve their Bridge skills and pleasing that the ABF is willing to provide support to current and prospective Bridge teachers by paying for Joan to come and conduct the teaching session.
